English Minor Requirement Checklist

General Requirements:

- Eighteen (18) credits of English courses are required, excluding ENG 101 and ENG 100/106
- Twelve (12) of the 18 credits must be University of Maine courses
- A grade of at least C- is required in all English minor courses

Course Requirements:

Six courses, at least four (4) of which must include:

- Two of the following: ENG 170: Foundations of Literary Analysis, ENG 222: Reading Poems, ENG 271: Act of Interpretation
- Two 300 level literature courses

AND two (2) additional courses*

- Any two (2) courses at the 200 or 300 level
- **OR,** one (1) course at the 200 or 300 level and one (1) course at the 400 level

*additional courses can be writing and/or literature courses, in any combination
