

**Creative Writing Minor Requirement Checklist**  
*(Minors Declaring After 9/1/12)*

**General Requirements:**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Minimum number of credits required to earn minor is 18
- \_\_\_\_\_ Minor can only be declared after the completion of ENG 205 with a grade of B or better
- \_\_\_\_\_ 12 of the 18 credits must be University of Maine courses
- \_\_\_\_\_ A grade of at least C- is required in all courses counted toward the minor

**Please note:** 300 and 400-level writing courses require the submission of a manuscript and instructor approval to enroll. Priority will be given to English Majors concentrating in creative writing and Creative Writing minors.

**Required 6 credits:**

**ENG 205:** Introduction to Creative Writing

Either **ENG 222** Reading Poems or **ENG 170** Foundations of Literary Analysis (we suggest that students with a stronger interest in poetry take 222; those with a stronger interest in fiction take 170)

**Plus 12 more credits:**

Four upper level Creative Writing Workshops (pick four from the following): **307, 308, 309, 405, 408** (Note: any 400-level Workshops may be repeated once for credit).
